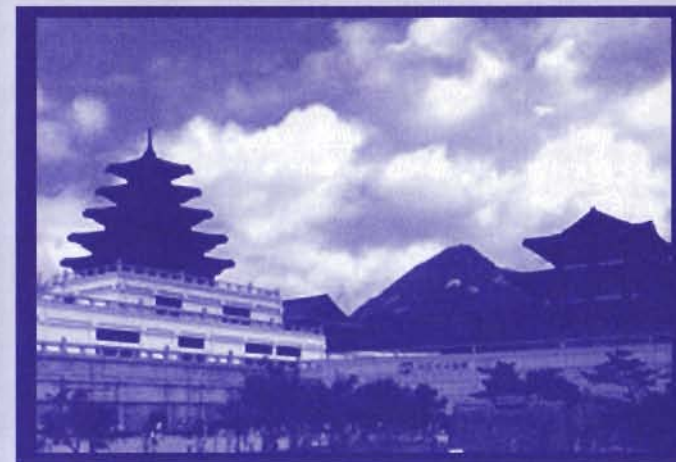

**Seoul – The Conference Destination**



Seoul is located in the centre of Korean peninsular, surrounded by beautiful and big rocky mountains. The Han River protected the enemy from South, and was connected to the sea, which is good for transportation, drinking, farming etc. Along with Han River, there are huge rice field to cultivate.

Seoul city was called Wiryesusung, then Hansung, then Kyungsung and finally Seoul city up till today. The location of Wiryesusung is supposed to be the current Olympic Park in East South of Seoul.
